

## Absences for Holidays, Medical Appointments and Other Events Reminder

If parents wish to take their child(ren) out of school for any reason, other than for medical appointments, they need to complete an Absence Request Form, available from the school office and on our website. All requests for absence should be made at least 2 week in advance, with the form being handed in to the office. The Head teacher reviews each request and decides whether or not to authorise the absence. Parents are advised by Parentmail if the absence is approved or in writing if it is unauthorised. Unauthorised absence is recorded and will appear on your child's report at the end of the year and is reported to the local authority.

For medical/dental appointments and sickness please notify school via ParentMail, providing date and time of appointment and when the child will be returning.

This term Hedgehog Class have been learning about Health and Life Cycles across the curriculum. In Science they have looked at the life cycles of plants and animals and have been outside exploring different habitats, as well as learning about life cycles through a talk at the Cotswold Wildlife Park.

In History, they have focused more on changes in how our health has been looked after, learning about how the NHS started and looking at how hospitals and nursing have changed over time by studying the lives of three inspirational nurses – Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell.



The children particularly enjoyed getting up close to the giraffes, the penguins and seeing both lions outside, as well as spotting some baby rhinos with their mothers! We were treated to an informative talk on life-cycles where we learnt about the giant tortoise, wallabies and ostriches, and the children really made us all proud by sharing their extensive Scientific knowledge with the Wildlife Park staff! Well done children.

The day ended with some well-earned free time in the playground, and the children behaved amazingly throughout the day. Thank you to all adults who accompanied us on the trip and enabled us to give the children such a wonderful experience.
