Have a wonderful weekend



SEND Support

Welcome back to everyone from the SEND Team at Derry Hill. We would like to let you know some key information about SEND Support for this academic year. I am Mrs Asfaw, the SENCO, and I am happy to be continuing in this role at Derry Hill for another year, alongside teaching in year 2 and year 6 this year, too. My SEN focused days in school are Wednesday and Thursdays. If you are worried about your child's progress, the best person to talk to in the first instance is their class teacher, but if they feel that your child may have additional needs they might suggest that I carry out some further assessments or observations of them to help us understand how best to support them. If your child is already on the SEN Register, their teachers will be working this term on setting up new ITTs for them (Individual Target Trackers). We have delayed these until the end of term 1 so that teachers have more time to get to know the children and assess what targets will best support them to progress and the new ITTs will be shared with you once they are ready. These will then be reviewed at the end of terms 3 and 5, or sooner if the children meet their targets more quickly. Children who have Speech and Language targets will also have target sheets related to these.
