4 Kinds of Sentences

Statement

- A **statement sentence** tells about something.
- It ends with a .

Examples:

I had a good time.

We ate pizza for lunch.

They went to the store.

Question

- A **question sentence** asks something.
- It ends with a ?

Examples:

What is the rabbit eating?

When do we eat lunch?

How are you?

Command

- A **command sentence** tells someone to do something.
- It ends with a .

Examples:

Please feed the dog.

Eat all your vegetables.

Do your chores after lunch.

Exclamation

- An **exclamation sentence** shows strong feeling.
- It ends with a !

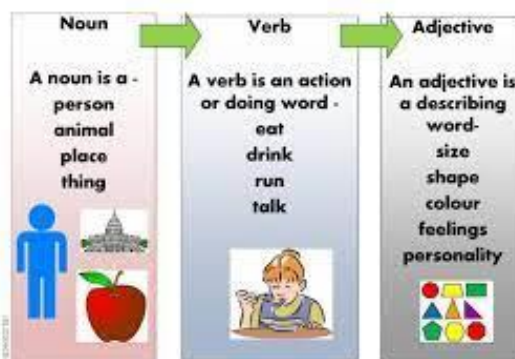
Examples:

The dog ate my homework!

He fell off the chair!

I just won 100 dollars!
