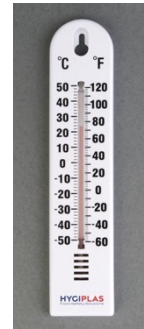
We use our

windsock.

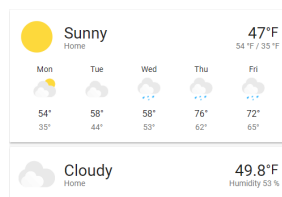


We can measure
