You can buy nice bread there.

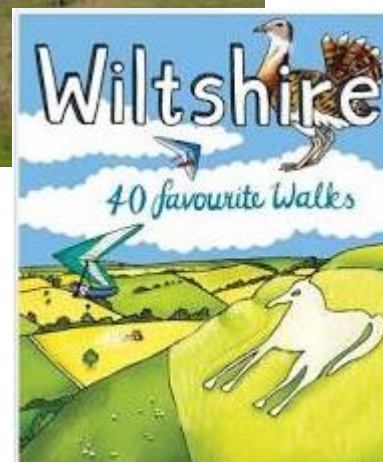
It opens at 9am.
