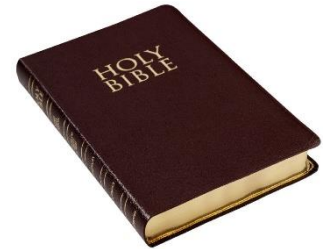


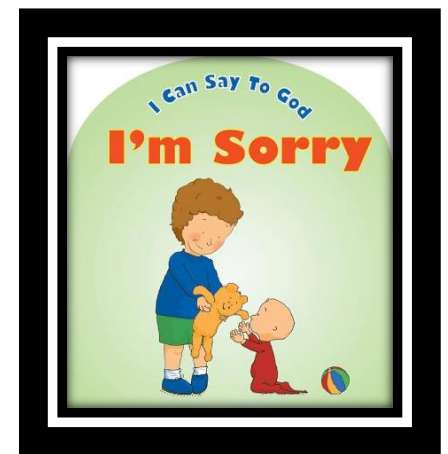


What is the Good News Jesus brings?

| Key Words | |

| Gospel | The good news that Jesus brought. This was told in the New Testament of the Bible. |
| Disciples | The 12 close friends of Jesus who he chose to help him spread the Good News of God's love. |
| forgiveness | Letting go of anger when someone says 'sorry' and being able to start again. |
| confession | Saying when you have done something wrong and saying sorry. |
| friendship | Showing everyone kindness and love. |
| peace | The act of feeling calm and relaxed. There are 4 kinds of peace – peace in our hearts, peace between friends, peace with other countries and peace with God. |
| prayer | Asking or thanking God for something. |
| The Lord's Prayer | The prayer that Jesus taught people to say and which shares the Good News. |
| trust | Believing in somebody and knowing they will help you. |
| New Testament | The second part of the Bible that tells us about Jesus' life. |
