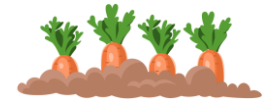

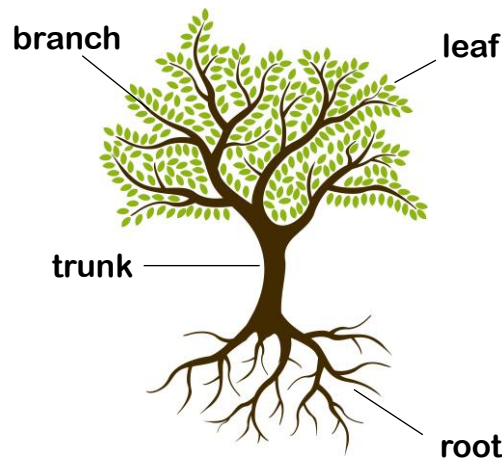

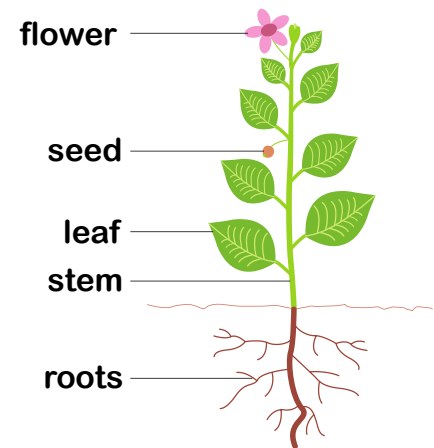

grow	to get bigger and change over time
seasons	changes in weather and temperature throughout the year.
wild	flowers that are not planted by a person but have spread their own seeds
flower	part of a plant that has petals
root	part of a plant that grows underground

stem	part of the plant that supports the flower
seed	a small part of a plant that can grow into a new plant
