Optional	Creating a volcano At the moment the weather is so hot it feels like were on the inside of a volcano! I wonder if you could create your own volcano. You can use any material you wish, e.g. junk modelling, Lego, natural resources, paper and crafts etc.	Painting Can you paint a picture of what you've been doing over the last couple of days? Perhaps you could add some labels to your picture or write a diary entry to explain what you've been up to - remember to use your phoneme fingers!
	'By the sea' tray If you have any sand at home perhaps you could create your own 'by the sea' tray. You could create things to go in your tray (for example sea creatures, buckets, spades) or add water and some shells. Why not try researching information about beaches across the world or how different the seaside looks now compared to 50 years ago.	Create a number line Can you collect lots of natural resources - maybe from your garden or if you manage to get outside from a local walk and create your own number line. Write numerals down on pieces of paper and see if you can match the quantity to the number using the loose parts you've collected.
