If you need some more activities to keep you busy, here are some ideas.

Grown-ups, everything here is optional, just a few ideas and activities to keep young ones busy if you so wish.

Science - senses

Can you be really quiet for 5 minutes (that's a long time to be very quiet, you might just want to try 2 minutes) and see how many different sounds you can hear? You can do this inside and outside, although in the shade during a cooler part of the day! Do any of the sounds surprise you? Are there any sounds that you hadn't noticed before? Were there more sounds inside or outside?

Ask your grown up to put an item inside a bag or box (you mustn't be able to see what's inside) and see if you can guess what's in there, through touching and feeling only. Can you describe what you feel? Is it hard, soft, rough, smooth...?

English

If you want to do some more writing, have a look at the pictures I've uploaded to the webpage. Choose a picture and write some sentences to describe it. Don't forget your capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Remember your adjectives (describing words) and think carefully about your letters (we've been practising the one-armed robot letters – *down and up*).

Art

We've been colour mixing this term, making secondary colours from primary colours and using white and black to make different tints and shades. You could do some more colour mixing and practise making lots of different tints (adding white) and shades (adding black). If you don't have paints you could use chalks and water, or just have some fun drawing a lovely summer-time picture.
