The Wonder of Our World

- Some things are man-made and some are natural.
- Christians and Jews believe God is the Creator
- Creation can make us wonder and ask questions

Shabbat

- Jewish people believe God created the world.
- Shabbat begins on Friday evening and ends on Saturday evening.
- It is a time for rest, family, worship and appreciation.
- Shabbat connects with the creation story because God rested

Caring for Our World

- Christians believe people should care for creation. This is called Stewardship.
- Jewish teachings also encourage people to care for the world.

The Creation Story

- Christians believe God created: light, sky, land, seas, plants, sun, moon, stars, animals and humans.
- Christians believe creation is good.

Humans Are Special

- Humans are part of God's creation. They can show kindness, creativity and compassion.
- Christians and Jews believe every person is special and valuable.
- People have responsibilities towards others and the natural world.

Who Is the Creator?

- Christians and Jews believe God created the world.
- Creation is valuable.
- Humans are part of creation. We have responsibility to care for creation.
- People may have different ideas about where the world came from.
